- 8 (a) Inspectors General Report.—Not later than

the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency shall submit to Congress a report that— 3 (1) lists each bank account held by the United 4 States Government that has balance of zero dollars 5 for 180 days or more; and 6 (2) recommends which of these accounts should 7 be immediately closed. 8 (b) CLOSURE OF ACCOUNTS REQUIRED.—Not later than 7 days after the report is submitted under subsection (a), the head of each agency with a bank account rec-10 ommended for closure in the report described in subsection 12 (a) shall close each such account that is managed by the 13 agency. 14 (c) AGENCY DEFINED.—In this section, the term 15 "agency" has the meaning given that term in section 551

16 of title 5, United States Code.
