I am requesting funding for the Northumberland Public Safety Building in Fiscal Year 2024.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Northumberland, located at 19 Main Street, Northumberland, N.H. 03582.

The funding would be used for construction of a police station, emergency medical services, and emergency operations center. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer's funds because it will provide a safe and essential operational space for first responders, improve the department's ability to protect the community, and serve as a space for multi-department training.
